

Guidance to Technical Officials - Experimental Scoring System - September 2016 - December 2017

To assist those Referees and Umpires officiating at upcoming events using the experimental 5 x 11 scoring system, please use the following special revised wording for RTTO 3.3.8.

All additional text is highlighted in yellow:

3.3.8 At the end of each game, "Game" must always be called immediately after the conclusive rally has ended, regardless of applause. Where appropriate this constitutes the start of any interval allowed under Law 16.2.2.

After the first game ends, call:

"First game won by [name(s) of player(s), or team (in a team championship)] [score]".

After the second game ends, call:

"Second game won by [name(s) of player(s), or team (in a team championship)] [score]"; One game all".

or, if appropriate, "(player or team) leads two games to zero".

After the third game ends, call:

"Third game won by (player or team)", and, if appropriate: "(player or team) leads two games to one".

After the fourth game ends call:

"Fourth game won by (player or team)" and, if appropriate: "Two games all".

At the end of each game, the service judge, where appointed, shall ensure that the court is mopped during the interval and place the interval board, if provided, at the centre below the net.

If a game wins the match, call instead:

"Match won by {name(s) of player(s), or team (in a team championship)}[scores]".
